

- The community and the home as settings for a good life.




WHERE DOES SPAIN STAND ON ITS JOURNEY TO COMMUNITY CARE FOR ALL PERSONS IN NEED?

 Who needs support for community living?

- Family care remains the backbone of long-term care.
- It is based on rigid categorisations and standardised responses that impede a person-centred approach.
- Does not meet people's desires.

The lack of support networks, difficult access to housing, and the absence of responses designed to enable people to live in the community are at the root of the processes of institutionalisation.


