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Why Competencies, Not Titles?

Interactive Example

"Ana was a teacher in Ukraine. What competencies do you think she has?"

Ana's Competencies • Communication • Organisation • Lesson planning • Group management • Problem solving	These competencies transfer to: • Corporate trainer • Educational project coordinator • School counsellor • Educational administrator
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The fundamental difference: We don't only look at diplomas (Qualifications), but at the practical abilities acquired through life and work experience (Skills) — competencies transferable into the new professional context in Romania.

The Technology Behind It — Simply Explained

AI (Artificial Intelligence) • Recognises experiences and suggests competencies • Recommends suitable jobs based on the beneficiary's profile	ESCO — European Database • Over 14,000 competencies • Over 3,000 jobs recognised across the EU • Used by the EU, OECD, and international organisations
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- Learns from context to refine recommendations

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Practical Tips — How to Get the Best Results

First Session

Offer 30 guided minutes for the first access. Suggest completing at least 3 experiences to generate a meaningful profile.

Use the Data in Counselling

Prepare with the generated CV before the meeting. Discuss identified competency gaps and what training might bridge them.

Track Progress Monthly

Check the portal once a week. Document results directly in the platform to build a full picture of each beneficiary's journey.

Advanced Platform Features

Personalised Reports

Export CSV/PDF with all beneficiaries. Filter by competencies, target jobs, and progress. Graphical visualisation of competency distribution.

Group Management

Groups by categories (e.g. women, youth, IT). Send tasks and resources to groups. Monitor group progress collectively.

Integration with Local Services

Add links to accredited courses. Personalised recommendations for professional training. Connections with local employers from the database.

Multilingual Support

Available in 18 languages including Ukrainian, Romanian, and English. Removes language as a barrier to profiling.



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How Do We Measure Success? — Simple Metrics

For beneficiaries: • How many have created a profile? • How many have found a job or course? • What competency gaps were identified?	For counsellors: • How much time do I save per session? • Can I help more people in the same time? • Are services more personalised?
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All data is visible on the portal — easy to track, easy to report.

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Next Steps — Actions for Case Managers

Starting 15 December Access the portal and explore the interface. Test inviting a pilot beneficiary.	January Create an event (together with partners) for Ukrainian refugee beneficiaries to familiarise them with the application and map the competencies of at least 30 participants.	January–February Review the profiles created. Download the first report. Share feedback with the SkillLab team.
