Vienna Youth Support Back to the Future

- ① **“We want to place even greater emphasis on the training- and employment orientation of the WMS (Vienna guaranteed minimum income), in order to prevent a consolidation of the WMS benefit as early as possible.”**

Target Group

- ① People either without or with insufficient employment integration
- ② People furthest from the labor market with little employability and working capability
- ③ Young recipients of WMS benefit between 18 and 24, who up to now have not had a realistic chance of employment, either through further education or qualification or by means of employment services

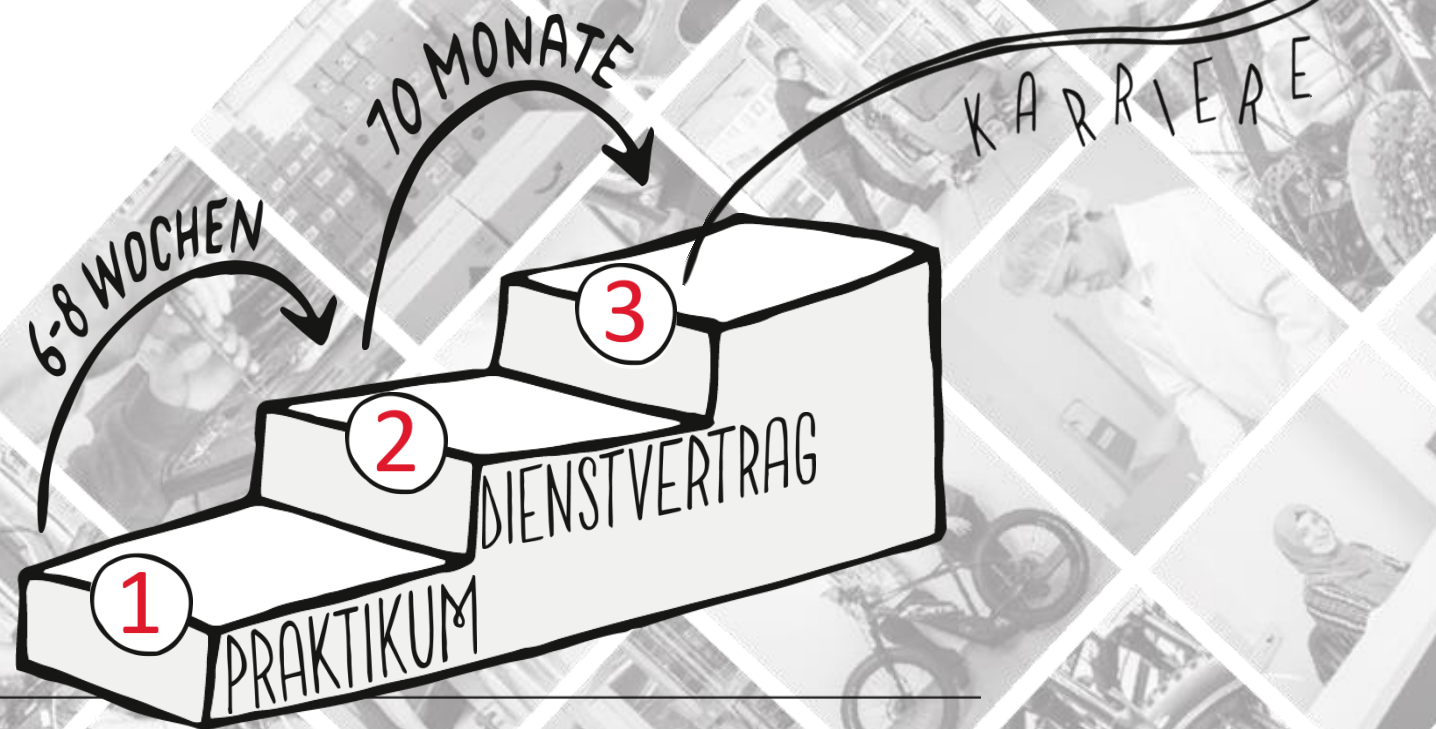

Operative Goals of Craft Jobs

- ① After the preparatory phase 65% of the participants are employed as transit employees (TAKs)
- ② Three months after leaving, 25% of all TAKs are in employment (not marginal, on the first labor market or vocational training)
- ③ Own earnings at least 20% of the costs

Max. 12 Months at Craft Jobs

- ① Start of preparatory phase
- ② Service contract
- ③ Fit for the labor market

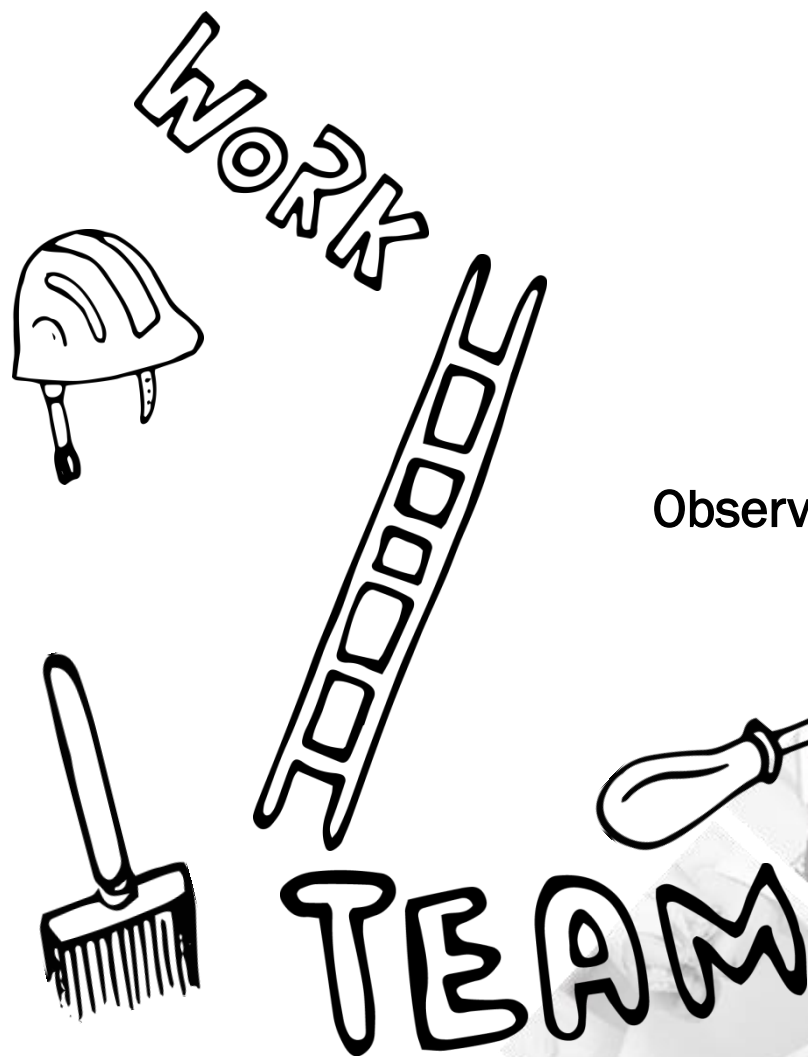

The Preparatory Phase

Start of preparatory phase: 24 hours/week

Working hours: Various working time models

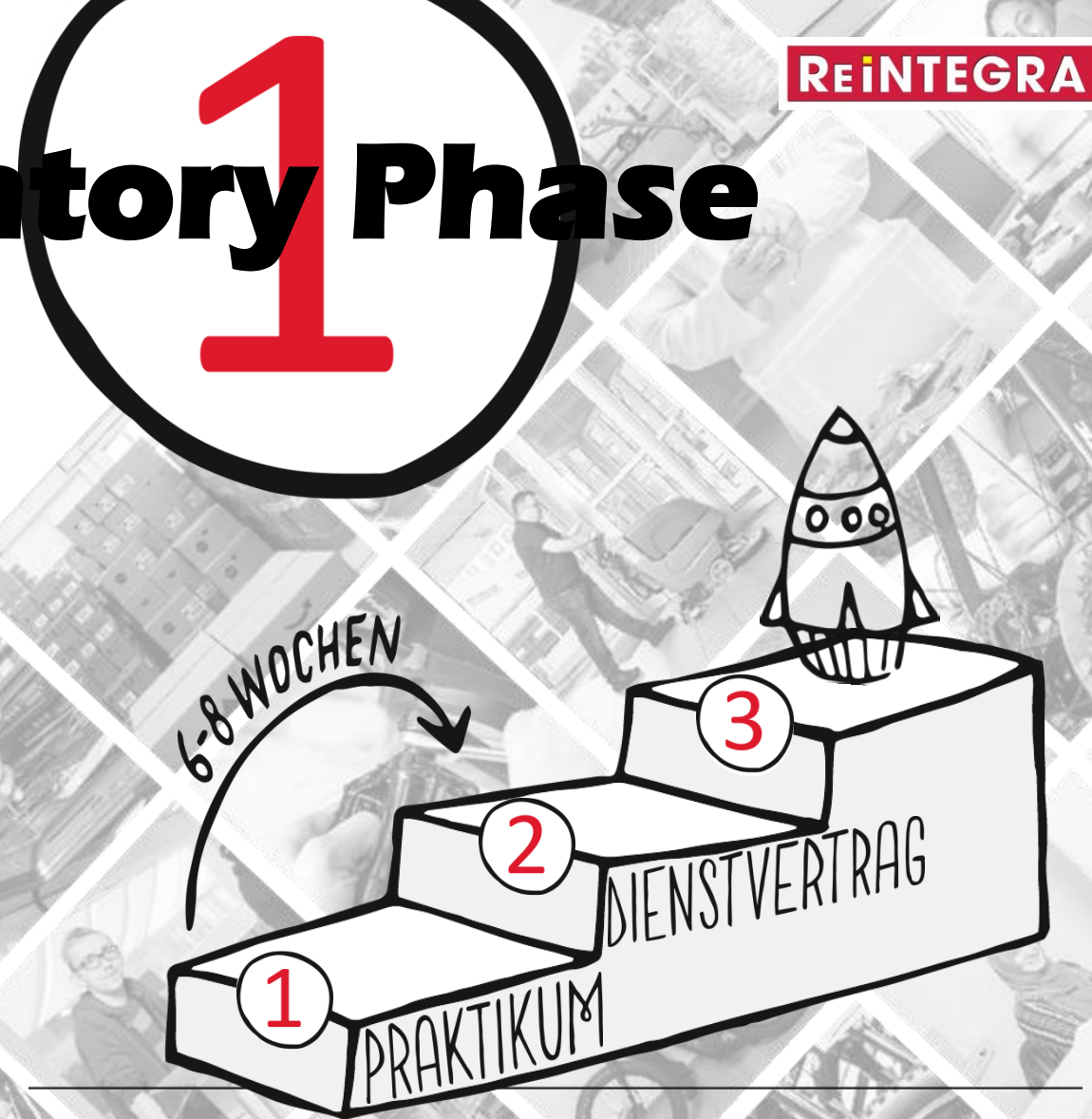
Breaks: 15min + 15min

Location: Manner, Craftjobs, AfB

Wage: As up to now from MA40/AMS

After 6 to 8 weeks:

Service contract, if pass all
preconditions.



The Service Contract Phase

Hours per week: 24h (later 28h possible)

Wage: My wage is paid by Craft Jobs

Collective agreement SWÖ

13th and 14th salary

20 days vacation aliquot

Termination of the contract, with ...

- > non-observance of the target agreement
- > unexcused absenteeism
- > unpunctuality
- > disregard of instructions

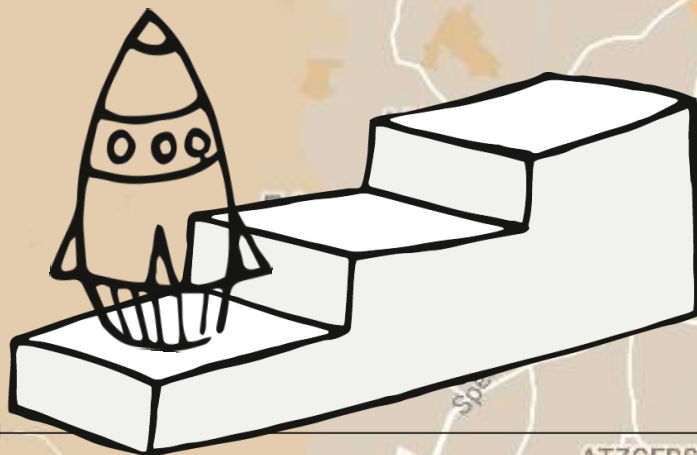

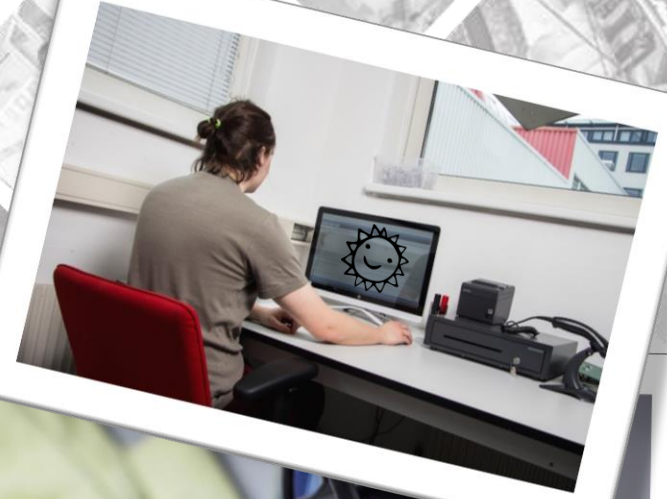
