The mission of the child protection service in France is to lead children and young people aged 16 to 25 towards autonomy. For this purpose, the social services offer them a pre-majority assessment in accordance with the <u>2016 law on child protection</u> . However, the child protection services lacked a dynamic tool that the youth and the social worker could use to prepare for this assessment, which involves reactive and continuous exchanges.

Providing children and young people with essential information for their life course regarding housing, school and university life, training, employment, administrative procedures, health, leisure, and culture. Offering a secure exchange channel between children under a child protection measure or teenagers accompanied by social services and their social worker or educator. 	
Activities: Please describe the activities put in place to achieve the objectives (maximum 300 words).	Based on a legal obligation, the child protection services have developed a tool aimed at the integration and autonomy of young people, especially those under child protection, as soon as their majority approach. This tool makes the young person a key player in their journey while allowing them to access up-to-date information to help them build their path to autonomy. The online application "Futur en Main" is innovative in its possibilities of interaction and exchange. It allows young people to send messages to their educators anytime and receive a response throughout their journey.	
	 The online application provides two types of services Supporting and guiding as best as possible the vulnerable children in their life course (a practical, intuitive app, structured) Facilitating exchanges between child protection services and the children (via a connected space) 	
Outcomes: Please explain what the results were/are so far and how you evaluated this.	180 accounts were created on the application by children and teenagers, and their educators are active. 5000 visitors to the site have been registered since October 2023.
